Clerk's report

Canal and River Trust

The Clerk has been contacted by Richard Birch from the Trust, therefore, representatives and for the meeting are required, together with an agenda.

Temporary Road Closures

Hollyhurst Road, Wrenbury Ward, Nantwich, CW5 8HT from Wrenbury Road and New Road Junction to approximately 100 metres past the bridge. 09:00am on Friday 19th January 2018 until 18:00 on Monday 22nd January 2018 works will then be suspended. Work will recommence at 22.00 on Saturday 27th January 2018 until 10.00AM on the Sunday 28th January 2018. The closure is necessary to enable Network Rail to carry a out bridge inspection and ground condition surveys. The alternative route will be via the following streets: - Marbury Road, Wrenbury Road, Hollins Lane, Hollyhurst Road.

Wrenbury Road, Wrenbury Ward, Nantwich, CW5 8EB from Wrenbury Level Crossing to 100 meters along station road. Saturday 10th February 2018 to Sunday 11th February 2018 & Saturday 17th February 2018 to Sunday 18th February 2018. The closure is necessary to enable Network Rail to carry out Access for flail. The alternative route will be via the following streets: Station Road, Nantwich Road, Wrenbury Heath Road, Newtown Road, Whitchurch Road, Wrenbury Road.
