The Device was in location from 23 to 26 January 2018. There were 4,568 vehicles that passed the device during this time, with an average speed of 25.7mph. There were 19.5% (892) of vehicles that travelled in excess of the speed limit. There were 73 vehicles that travelled over 40mph. The majority of the speeding occurred between 11pm and 8am.

The device was in location again between 13 and 16 February 2018. During this period, 5,093 vehicles passed the device, with an average speed of 29.3mph. Approximately 2,000 vehicles broke the speed limit, with 18% in excess of 35mph. This speeding was constant throughout the day.
