

## **Wrenbury cum Frith Parish Council**

### **Publication of the Wrenbury cum Frith Neighbourhood Plan (Pre-Submission Version)**

#### **The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (Regulation 14)**

Wrenbury cum Frith Parish Council, as the qualifying body, has prepared a Neighbourhood Plan for the period to 2030 (the Plan) for Wrenbury cum Frith Parish with the help of the local community. The Plan sets out a vision for the future of the parish and planning policies which will be used to determine planning proposals locally.

Wrenbury cum Frith Parish Council is now inviting comments on the proposals in this Pre-Submission version of the Plan before it is submitted to Cheshire East Council for formal consideration and wider consultation.

The consultation opens for comment on 16th April 2018. The deadline for comments to be received by Wrenbury cum Frith Parish Council is 5pm on 17th June 2018. Printed copies of the Plan can be viewed at the following locations:
